Trot the Trails Event on August 19th

On Saturday, August 19th, Frances and Wayne Baker are hosting a 'Trot the Trails' Event at their Hollyville Farm in Harbeson, Delaware. An entry form for the event is on page 6. Please complete this form an return it to Frances no later than 8/12/23.

What is this event and who can participate? All vehicles and equines are eligible to participate as long as you pass the safety check. The Trail Drive and the cones course are not speed events, but learning events. Whips are mandatory and helmets are encouraged. The Driving Derby is geared more towards speed, but there is a Training Level which is a learning experience where only a walk or trot is permitted. Volunteers are also needed!

A Whip's (Driver) Meeting will begin at 10 am in the front of the barn. Instructions, trail maps, and the cones course/Driving Derby map will be distributed and discussed. Individuals driving only the Trails will be sent on course beginning at 11 am. If you are driving both the Trails and Cones —you will have the opportunity to walk the cones (course is located near the barn) prior to driving the cones course. Non-participants will have the opportunity to walk the course with a knowledgeable person and then 'spectate' during the running of the cones course.

Individuals participating in the Driving Derby area will complete 2 rounds of the course —the first one will be done 'blind'. The Driving Derby will be located in the arena area of the trails course

There will be an optimum time for the Trail Course and Cones Coursefor learning purposes. For the Driving Derby: the participant's score is the sum of scores for both rounds and the lowest time (score) wins. Prizes will be awarded.

Lunch will be provided!

Helpful Hints!

Nice idea for the summer months: freeze gallon jugs of water and place them in horse's water tanks to keep drinking water cool.






Good Stock Trailer Cooling Idea—a large PVC elbow and a heavy duty zip tie will scoop in lots of air which can be directed right at the horse(s). They can be turned to send fast air all over the trailer and help cool horses along the way. If you're worried about debris—simply put a screen wire or nylon over the intake. You should make sure your horse has a mask on as well in open stock trailers

Hot weather tip: Use Listerine mouth wash to clean water tanks/buckets. It cuts algae quickly, KILLS MOSQUITO LARVA, and leaves a pleasant smell (unlike bleach). If you buy an off brand make sure it has the same alcohol content as Listerine.
