**DDC March 2013 BOD Minutes**

Present: Jane Ramsey, Carol Seiler, Sherry Harris, Donna Hurst, Noble Cahall, Pao Lin Hatch, Jackie McCann, Martha MacDonald

Secretary's minutes and Treasurer's report were accepted as printed.

**Old Business:** Jane Bailey and Samea Baker have donated a silver bowl as a perpetual trophy for the Pat Markl Memorial to the over-all high point horse/handler in the in-hand classes. There will be classes for Pony, Horse, VSE and Draft. The winner of each division will compete in the final class for the trophy. The winner's name will be engraved on the bowl and the winner will take home a ribbon. John Laird will be the announcer and Frances Coker will be the ringmaster. The Mid-Atlantic Challenge will continue in 2013 with a 4 show series including DDC, Bucks County (PA), Samea's show in PA and a 4th show TBD. An ad has been placed in the Horse of Delaware Valley and an article about the Pat Markl trophy will be in the April issue. The prize list will be ready within 2 weeks both electronically and hardcopy. Members are needed as volunteers, sponsors and for donations to the silent auction. Lois and Noble Cahall volunteered during the meeting. The ribbons have been ordered.

**Calendar events:** The pavillion has been reserved for the Blackbird drive on 4/13. A general meeting will be held after the drive. A note will be put in the newsletter. The 4/21 Cones Clinic has been cancelled due to lack of volunteers available on that day. There will be a Redden Forest drive on 6/29 with a general meeting to follow.

The decision regarding the purchase of a sound system was tabled, awaiting further data from Sherry Harris and her husband.

A 'Spending Committee' will kick off on 6/1 chaired by Jane Ramsey with Pao Lin Hatch and Sherry Harris to serve. They will begin long range planning for the club and how to use the money currently in our reserve.

The trailer use was reviewed. Most of the equipment for the show is stored there and Donna Hurst has agreed to keep the

trailer on her farm. The registration will be allowed to lapse as it is no longer taken on the road. Thanks were extended to Donna for her generosity.

The MidAtlantic Drive will be posted in the newsletter with a continued request for volunteers to sponsor a breakfast representing DDC. Pao Lin will confirm whether or not volunteers would have to pay the day fee to participate.

It was decided to set up a PayPal Account for DDC to allow members to renew, sign up for clinics or parties and pay by credit card on a secure site. While there is a small fee for the service, it was felt offering the convenience of on-line registration and payment would benefit the members, guests and the club.

The Delaware National Guard offers a low cost one week summer camp for Guard members and families. DDC has been asked to bring horses and make a presentation about horses, horse care and potentially offer carriage rides. Donna Hurst offered to bring her horse Moose and an article will be written for the newsletter.

Jane Ramsey reviewed the new transportation regulations for MD and especially Cecil County. As of March 1, horsemen could be fined for any manure left in the county but that is not going to be enforced until after further meetings have been held. The DE State vet says they will basically remain with their standard of an annual Coggins and flu-rhino requirements. The 4H office reported that they would use the old standard of a valid Coggins.

The by-laws will be revisited and any proposed changes or corrections will be presented at the Redden Forest Drive and the August program.

*Eagles Nest Lane Still Pond Maryland This will be based on ADS style Continuous Driving event, with dressage, cones, and a cross country pace of no more than 3km, over fields, and farm lanes, but no public access roads Dress is casual but clean, gloves, whip, hat or helmet necessary, apron optional*

- ⇒ *Dressage test will be ADS test Training level #3 and may be read by a groom to the driver on the carriage*
- ⇒ *The cones course will be no more than 14 gates*
- ⇒ *Cross country to have several simple (and hopefully entertaining) tasks, and no more than 3 obstacles of 3 gates each; Obstacles will not be timed*
- ⇒ *Cross country placement will be determined by time closest to ideal time and set points will be awarded for completion of tasks*
  - ◆ *A 50/50 command class will be held the last driver left will receive 50% of entry fees for that class, \$5 per turnout ; All horses, ponies, VSE, draft will be in one class; 50% to be donated to DDC Club and time to be determined on the day of the event*
  - ◆ *This is a schooling event, and drivers of all skill levels are welcome*
  - ◆ *This is a training type of event, and green, but safe horses are welcome The organizer and judge reserve the right to excuse any driver or horse not seen to be safe*
  - ◆ *Classes will be divided by VSE, Pony, Horse, and multiples and ribbons will be given in each division Classes may be divided or combined depending on entries. If there are enough entries, a draft division will be held*
