



General Members Meeting Minutes

7/19/2014 Easton, MD

President Donna Hurst called the meeting to order at 12:50pm. John Bolinski spoke briefly about the DDC Camp Colwell event scheduled this month and the need for volunteers and how rewarding the event was for all participants last year. Pao Lin Hatch spoke briefly about the DDC Holiday Party which is scheduled on Saturday, Dec 6, 2014 at Tuckahoe Equestrian Center Clubhouse in Ridgely, MD. This will be a daytime covered dish brunch, with a short annual general meeting, election of 2015 officers and board members and a short drive, weather permitting. The cost for renting the club house and ground is \$150.00. Donna Hurst reports that Anna Klumpp has resigned as DDC Treasurer but will remain on the board as a Director. John Bolinski has assumed acting Treasurer Position until the end of the year.

Sherry Harris reported on the 1987 DDC trailer and current condition in detail. The trailer, which is aluminum, has several holes in the roof, although the inside is in savable condition. Frances Baker volunteered to chair a committee to look into the various options and make a recommendation to the Board which will make a recommendation to the membership. On the committee is Diane Savage, Sherry Harris and John Bolinski. George Parris announced he will lead and chair a DDC Fun Show for 2014 and hopes that the membership will support him.

Donna Hurst adjourned the meeting at 1:14 pm.
