Level Descriptions

Level I

The basic level (but not for complete beginners) is for those ready to drive away from home. This is a competence evaluation and will confirm that you know how to do things safely. This level covers harness knowledge, harnessing and putting to, practical driving, horse care and general knowledge of a single turnout.

Level II

This level is suited to the more experienced driver who participates in some form of competitive driving and it may include pair driving. The prerequisites for this level are successful completion of Level I and the Road Driving assessment followed by additional driving instruction/experience. Typical drivers at this level must be able to drive an unfamiliar single horse, work competently in a driving environment with some responsibility, drive competently in company and perhaps in competition, and look after a group of horse/ponies competitively and maintain them over a period of time both in work and at rest. **If interested, you MUST confirm availability with Jane or Francis. See above!**




