# Bits and Pieces—Club Information

A DDC General **Membership Meeting** was held on February 2, 2023 via Zoom and the minutes from the January 5th Board Meeting were approved as submitted. The Treasury report had a starting balance of \$11,067.30 on January 1st. Expenses totaled \$2144.44 and deposits were \$925.00, leaving an ending balance of \$9847.86. The report was accepted as presented. The General Membership Board reviewed and approved the 2023 Budget as presented and the completed Treasury Audit had no identified issues.

A motion was made to make a donation in the amount of \$150 to the Delaware Equine Scholarship Program. Each year the DEC awards a \$1500 scholarship to one or more individuals who meet the required criteria and are

enrolled and in good standing at an agricultural or equine course of study or related field, or a veterinary or vet tech program in the US.

Based upon the recent results of a Club poll, the DDC will now accept electronic payments for everything from membership to clinic fees. The Club has setup a PayPal Business account and more information will be sent to members via an email.

# Understanding a Sporting Day of Traditional Driving

Many thanks go to DDC Members Frances and Wayne Baker for hosting the Understanding the Sporting Day of Traditional Driving Workshop on January 7th at their Hollyville Farm in Harbeson, DE. Sporting Day of Traditional Driving is based on the very popular European event called Attelage de Tradition. Recently the Carriage Association of America was designated as the United States

Representative to this organization and since the Attelage de Tradition competition format is strictly set and governed, the DDC decided to learn more about their format. Through a grant, the DDC was able to secure David Saunders as the Clinician. David, who has judged and participated in many North American and European events, shared his vast knowledge in an interesting and entertaining way. This interactive workshop allowed the over thirty participants to see different vehicles 'put to' and gain first hand knowledge of how fun and special this event is. DDC Member Michele Brauning and her pair of VSEs and Jane Oehler, from PA, with her Florida Cracker Pony presented their turnouts for inspection and the participants were able to see what a Judge looks for in the Presentation Phase. A Power Point allowed the group to learn about what is expected in the other two phases: Road Driving and Cones Driving. Each turnout is competing against an ideal, rather than against the other turnouts. 

## Guilt Free Advice

This is an option that works on a lot of horses when needing to take medication in tablet form. Buy a cheap coffee/ herb grinder and add peppermints in with the tablets you're grinding. You can use other flavored hard candy if your horse isn't fond of peppermint. Takes only seconds to grind and the nasty taste of the pills is masked by the sticky peppermint candy.

Always discuss with your Vet any medications and possible interactions that may be of concern.







An inexpensive and easy to find way to store your harnesss— hose holders. They can also be bent for smaller sized harness. Another bonus is that decorative patterns are available on hose hangers now.



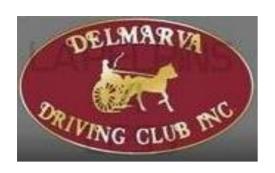
