# Hassan and the Christmas Ornament

As reported last month but here with more details....

CAA members Anne & Harry Hassan (Pennsylvania) sent this story and photo ...

There's a Christmas celebration each year in St Michaels, Maryland. All of the town's civic groups and churches are involved, but the high point of the weekend is a wonderful parade.

Years ago, the parade committee asked us to lead the parade with our Friesian pair, *Hette* and *Bert*, put to our Omnibus, and we did just that for ten years. We were always enthusiastically received.

We lost *Hette* in 2015, but the committee asked that we still lead the parade with *Bert* as a single. He did so for the first time last year, and we put him to our Brewster Norton Phaeton. Now we've been asked to have him do so again this year.

One of the things that the organizing committee does each year is have a local artist design a commemorative ornament, in metal, to celebrate the weekend.

Because the town is on the Chesapeake bay, the ornament has traditionally been a lighthouse, a boat, or some nautical theme.

This year, however, the committee came to us and asked if they could memorialize our horses and their participation by dedicating the ornament to them. Of course we considered it an honor and worked with the artist to help with the design.


