Board Meeting Minutes

Delmarva Driving Club Board Meeting - 2/2/2017

Meeting called to order at 7:04 p.m.

Anna Klumpp, Pao Lin Hatch, George Parris, Jane Bailey, Carol Seiler & Kim Baklarz announced that they are in attendance.

Treasurer's Report – approved as presented

Beginning Drive Clinic is being held tomorrow. Lead by George Parris.

April Furnace Town Drive has been postponed.

Trailer – New issue – In the minutes of June 2010 the DDC Board voted to not continue Delaware incorporation because of the fee. The Maryland incorporation was kept because it was free. Due to this, George could not register the trailer in DE. Pao Lin suggested registering the trailer in the state of Maine because the cost is less than Maryland. Discussion on the possibility of asking the trailer dealer to register it in Maine and/or contacting an agent to ask about the details of registering the trailer in Maine.

Jane made a motion – We proceed with registering the trailer in Maine. George & Pao Lin will take care of it with the total of trailer price, sales tax and registration not to exceed \$5,000 (which was the original limit of expenses for the purchase of the trailer). If needed, an o=icer will be contacted to sign a power of attorney.

Is DDC still incorporated in Maryland? Yes, however, the personal property forms need to be @led for 2016 and 2017.

Pao Lin – made a motion – We will ask Rich Graves (a CPA) to @le personal property forms to bring the club up to date with Maryland.
